Trinity Center is a non-residential program serving homeless adult men and women in Walnut Creek and Central Contra Costa County area. Trinity Center is a safe place to be off the street. It is a place “where they know my name”.

**What We Do:** Respite and community center for the homeless and working poor

- Open five days a week
- Breakfast and lunch Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
- Wednesday Women’s Day
- Daily onsite Services: showers, laundry, clothing, food
- Referral services
